



Thornburgh Endowed Chair in Finance

The Department of Finance in the College of Business at University of Cincinnati invites applications for a newly established Endowed Chair in Finance in corporate finance. The position has been established with a generous gift from Richard E. Thornburgh, vice-chairman of Corsair Capital. The appointment will be to the rank of associate or full professor, based on track record, with an anticipated start date of September 1, 2011.

The Chair is endowed to support research in finance. The successful candidate is expected to pursue nationally and internationally recognized research in corporate finance. Candidates must hold a PhD in finance or related discipline and must be an emerging or acknowledged expert in the study of corporate finance. This position requires a candidate with a strong research record and demonstrated promise of continuing excellence in research and in teaching at the undergraduate, master's and doctoral levels. The candidate hired for the chaired position will be expected to provide a leadership role in research endeavors and to interact with other faculty members. Salary will be commensurate with the candidate's record and competitive with other university finance departments/areas.
